FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 77-10

WHEREAS, the academic reputation of Louisiana State University has established a de-facto selective admissions policy, and

WHEREAS, formula funding as presently practiced is inconsistent with the concept of selective admissions, and

WHEREAS, federal regulations, societal considerations, and present educational trends are bringing increased responsibilities upon universities to broaden the concept of a university education,

BE IT RESOLVED that selective admissions at the Junior Division level not be implemented at this time, that selective admissions criteria continue to be applied at the senior college level in accordance with the educational mission and capabilities in terms of faculty and facilities of each college, and that the report of the Task Force on Selective Admissions be used as a guide in the counseling of prospective students,

AND BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that those charged with long-range planning for this campus articulate the definition of "comprehensive" and the future direction the educational mission of this campus will take in order that all concerned will have a common understanding of our future goals.
