FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 80-6

Upon the recommendation of its Committee on Personnel Policies, the Faculty Senate supports the Commission on Women in its petition for a revision of PS-12 as it pertains to benefits and restrictions relating to courses taken in the University:

1. The removal of the narrowly-interpreted job-related requirement;
 2. The removal of the three-year consecutive service requirement;
 3. Extension of the course fee rebate to 100 percent of fees;
 4. Extension of allowable fee rebates to six semester hours;
- Extension of these educational benefits to cover faculty as well as classified and unclassified staff.
