A FINANCE BILL

TO ALLOCATE SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHTEEN DOLLARS AND NINETY-SIX CENTS (\$718.96) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT LEGISLATIVE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND A MULTIMEDIA TECHNOLOGY LAB FOR UNDERGRADUTE RESEARCH WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES LIBRARY CURRENTLY SERVES AS A MEETING AND STUDY AREA FOR STUDENTS AND FACULTY; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, MORE UNDERGRADUTE INVOLVEMENT IN WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES RESEARCH HAS LED TO A NEED FOR A SUFFICIENT SPACE OUTFITTED WITH PROPER TECHNOLOGY FOR WEB CONFERENCES AND PRESENTATIONS; AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES LIBRARY WILL BE AVAILABLE TO ALL STUDENTS, BUT ITS USE WILL BE HEAVILY ENCOURAGED TO THE STUDENTS ENROLLED IN WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES COURSES; AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THE MULTIMEDIA TECHNOLOGY LAB WOULD ALLOW STUDENTS TO HONE COMMUNICATION SKILLS, DEVELOP PROFESSIONALIZATION AND NETWORKING, AND CONDUCT RESEARCH IN A CONDUCIVE ENVIRONMENT; AND

PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, THE MONEY SHALL BE ALLOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

1. 32" SMART HDTV 1080P - \$379.99
2. TV WALL MOUNT - \$99.99
3. TV WEB CAMERA 1080P HD - \$69.99
4. APPLE TV - \$149.00
5. AIRSERVER - \$19.99

PARAGRAPH 6: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE THAT SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHTEEN DOLLAR AND NINETY-SIX CENTS (\$718.96) BE ALLOCATED FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT LEGISLATIVE CONTINGENCY

ACCOUNT TO FUND AMULTIMEDIA TECHNOLOGY LAB FOR UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES, AND

PARAGRAPH 7: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS BILL BE TRANSMITTED TO ALISA JONES, STUDENT GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL COORDINATOR.

PARAGRAPH 8: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
