MR. A. BIGLER CROW

What does it take to make a good forestry professor? First, intelligence and a wide range of interest are required. Second, broad experience in the field. Third, enthusiasm for the forestry profession; and fourth, the ability to communicate both the subject and the enthusiasm for the subject in a clear and interesting manner. This year's ANNUAL RING is dedicated to Mr. A. Bigler Crow, a man who easily meets all of these conditions.

Since 1946, the quick wit and dynamic lectures of Mr. Crow have made his classes interesting and informative. The subjects of silviculture and forest protection are long remembered by his students.

For those who haven't met Mr. Crow the ANNUAL RING offers this introduction:

Mr. Crow was born in Warren, Pennsylvania in 1910 and grew up in Pittsburg. He attended Pennsylvania State Forest School, Montana State University and North Carolina State College where he received his B.S. degree in 1934. After working for the U. S. Forest Service in Missouri, Pennsylvania, and Maryland, Mr. Crow attended Yale and received his M.S. degree there in 1941. Later he worked for the Soil Conservation Service in Pennsylvania and Maryland, and for the American Forestry Association in Maryland, Delaware, Illinois, and West Virginia.

Since joining the L.S.U. staff, Professor Crow has served on several important university and forestry school committees. He has studied silviculture methods of 65 public and private forestry agencies in ten southern states under the auspices of the National Science Foundation. Also, he has been a deacon in the Presbyterian Church since 1949.

Mr. Crow is married to Margaret Rinaman of Pittsburg, Pennsylvania, and they have one daughter and one grandson, both of Baton Rouge. Mr. Crow holds membership in four honor societies, one social fraternity, and six professional and scientific organizations.

THE DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

It has been truly said that changing a curriculum is like moving a cemetery. In spite of two years of discussing the addition of a fifth year to the four-year bachelor's curriculum in forestry, we American forestry educators are no nearer to change than we were two years ago.

The long-awaited Dana report, "Forestry Education in America Today and Tomorrow," finally appeared in print last September. The heart of Dean Dana's recommendations is that (1) five years of college work is the minimum necessary for the education of a professional forester, and (2) a companion proposal that training of forest "technicians" in two-year technical schools should be expanded.

There is nothing new about Dana's conclusion about the need for a five-year curriculum. What is new is the thoroughness with which he substantiates his conclusion. And, while the forestry curriculum has remained essentially unchanged for many years, other professions have lengthened their academic programs in order to train students to cope with broader professional responsibilities. Professional fields requiring five or more years of study include medicine, theology, dentistry, hospital administration, law, osteopathy, social work, veterinary medicine, architecture, chiropody, library science, optometry, and pharmacy. Fields in which four-year programs prevail are accounting, agriculture, business administration, education, engineering, forestry, home economics, journalism, and nursing.

I agree with Dean Dana's recommendations. We must strengthen the forestry profession by requiring more academic credits for the basic professional degree. Many other foresters will feel the same. However, there are two major hurdles to cross before the forestry curriculum is lengthened: (1) Acceptance and simultaneous effectuation of the new standard by a large majority of forestry schools, and (2) adoption by the major employers of foresters of a policy of favoring graduates of the new program in initial appointments and initial salaries. Employers occupy a key position in raising educational standards. To those L.S.U. alumni who employ young foresters, I plead for your cooperation in this regard.

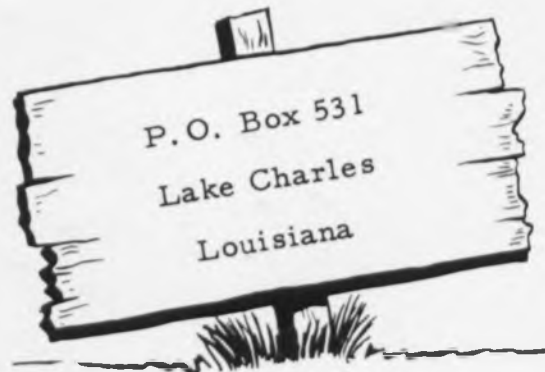

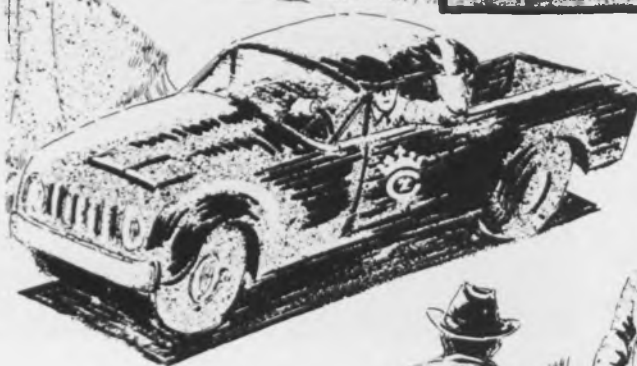

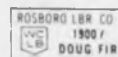
