FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 87-12

WHEREAS the policy requiring the instructor's signature for withdrawals from courses numbered below 3000 was requested by the Faculty Senate with the intention of providing helpful counseling to students before they make the decision to drop, and

WHEREAS there is little evidence that the desired results have been achieved, and

WHEREAS over half of the withdrawals in recent semesters have occurred during the last week before the deadline, leading to the breakdown of the system;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty Senate recommends that said policy be rescinded.
