FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 88-7

WHEREAS the faculty has sponsored a Performing Arts series for thirty years, and

WHEREAS this distinguished series has offered programs by internationally renowned artists to the LSU community, and

WHEREAS such performances are a vital part of the cultural life and educational program of the LSU community, and

WHEREAS the University budget funding which made this series possible has been decreased and finally eliminated;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty Senate strongly supports the continuance of the Performing Arts series and urges the Chancellor and the University administration to restore and increase the funding to \$32,000 for the Performing Arts Committee.
