A RESOLUTION

TO URGE AND REQUEST THE LSU STUDENT UNION TO PUT AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS IN EASILY ACCESSIBLE LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE BUILDING

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS ARE PORTABLE DEVICES THAT CAN RESTORE A NORMAL HEART RHYTHM FOR VICTIMS OF SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST; AND
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THERE ARE NO DEFIBRILLATORS CURRENTLY IN THE LSU STUDENT UNION AND ONLY 2 STATIONARY ON CAMPUS; AND
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE FOLLOWING SEC UNIVERSITIES AND PEER INSTITUTIONS HAVE MORE THAN 50 AEDS ACCESSIBLE THROUGH THEIR CAMPUSES: UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA, TEXAS A&M, AUBURN, ARKANSAS, VANDERBILT, AND GEORGIA; AND
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, HAVING AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR IN A QUICKLY ACCESSIBLE LOCATION HAS THE POTENTIAL TO SAVE AN INDIVIDUAL'S LIFE; AND
- PARAGRAPH 5:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE THAT MORE AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS BE PLACED IN EASILY ACCESSIBLE LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE LSU STUDENT UNION, AND
- PARAGRAPH 6:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO MARGOT CARROLL, ASSISTANT VICE PRESIDENT OF AUXILIARY SERVICES.
- PARAGRAPH 7:** THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY (ONE-HALF PLUS ONE) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
