A FINANCE BILL

TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF THREE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$3,030.50) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE CAREER SERVICES GOING GLOBAL PROGRAM AT LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY (LSU).

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY HAS BECOME THE TOP UNIVERSITY IN THE NATION WITH USING GOING GLOBAL; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, GOING GLOBAL BENEFITS THOUSANDS OF STUDENTS BY HELPING THEM FIND AND BE PREPARED FOR JOBS AND INTERNSHIPS ACROSS THE WORLD; AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE PROGRAM ALSO HELPS INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS BY FINDING JOBS AVAILABLE TO NON-CITIZENS IN AMERICA; AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, IN THE PAST FEW YEARS ALONE, OVER TWENTY THOUSAND STUDENTS HAVE USED THIS PROGRAM; AND

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF THREE THOUSAND AND THIRTY DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$3,030.50) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE CAREER SERVICES GOING GLOBAL PROGRAM; AND

PARAGRAPH 6: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS BILL BE TRANSMITTED TO JOAN C. GALLAGHER ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR, LSU CAREER SERVICES AND;

PARAGRAPH 7: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS ($2/3$) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT

AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE
DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
