A FINANCE BILL

**TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF SEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$7,000.00)
FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO FUND SUSTAINABLE
PLANTS FOR SPRING GREENING DAY 2018**

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, SPRING GREENING DAY IS AN ANNUAL HALF-DAY SERVICE PROJECT TO BEAUTIFY THE LSU CAMPUS; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE OFFICE OF SUSTAINABILITY IS HOSTING THIS EVENT TO SPRUCE UP THE LSU CAMPUS AND TO PROMOTE SUSTAINABILITY IN OUR ENVIRONMENT; AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT LEGISLATIVE BRANCH IDENTIFIES WITH THE ISSUE OF BEAUTIFICATION OF CAMPUS WHICH IS OUR PHILANTHROPIC DUTY, AND WE WOULD LIKE TO CONTRIBUTE TO SOLVING THIS ISSUE THROUGH FUNDING OF PLANTS FOR SPRING GREENING DAY 2018; AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION DOCUMENTS HOW SPECIFICALLY THE \$16,000 WILL BE DISTRIBUTED:

1. **ASIAN JASMINE - \$7,000.00**
 - a. **TOTAL - \$7,000.00**

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE THAT A MAXIMUM OF SEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$7,000.00) BE ALLOCATED FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO FUND SUSTAINABLE PLANTS FOR SPRING GREENING DAY 2018, AND

PARAGRAPH 6: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS BILL BE TRANSMITTED TO Ms. CORTNEY GREAVIS, STUDENT GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL COORDINATOR; AND SARAH TEMPLE, OFFICE OF SUSTAINABILITY, AND

PARAGRAPH 7: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
