11 PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE BENGAL LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP WAS AVAILABLE
12 FOR NONRESIDENT SONS AND DAUGHTERS OF LSU SYSTEM
13 GRADUATES WHO QUALIFY FOR REGULAR ADMISSION TO THE
14 UNIVERSITY; AND

15 PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, RECIPIENTS OF THIS AWARD WOULD RECEIVE A
16 SEVENTY -FIVE (75) PRECENT EXEMPTION OF THE NONRESIDENT
17 FEE; AND

18 PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE BENGAL LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP WAS ELIMINATED
19 IN 2011; AND

20 PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THE PRESIDENT OF THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION, CLIFF
21 VANNOY, WOULD LIKE TO REINSTATE THIS TUITION BREAK FOR
22 STUDENTS OF UNIVERSITY ALUMNI; AND

23 PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, VANNOY WOULD LIKE TO PARTNER WITH THE LSU
24 FOUNDATION AND THE LSU TIGER ATHLETIC FOUNDATION TO
25 BUILD AN ENDOWMENT THAT WILL ACCUMULATE INTEREST TO
