7 **A RESOLUTION**

8 **TO URGE AND REQUEST THAT THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY POLICE**
9 **DEPARTMENT REEVALUATE THEIR AMOUNT AND DISTRIBUTION OF CAMPUS SECURITY**
10 **CAMERAS**

11 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, CAMPUS SECURITY CAMERA ACCESS AND LOCATION
12 HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AS ISSUES OF CONCERN AT LSU; AND

13 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, INCREASING CAMERA COVERAGE OF CAMPUS COULD
14 PREVENT MORE REOCCURRING THEFT, VIOLENCE AND
15 VANDALISM CLAIMS, AND HELP CAMPUS INVESTIGATIONS FROM
16 CAR ACCIDENTS TO SERIOUS FELONIES; AND

17 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, PROVIDING MORE INFORMATION ON CAMERA
18 LOCATIONS ON THE LSU POLICE DEPARTMENT WEBSITE WITH
19 THE POTENTIAL OF LIVE FEEDS WOULD HELP EDUCATE
20 STUDENTS AND FACULTY ABOUT AREAS THAT REQUIRE
21 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES; AND

22 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, SOME AREAS OF CAMPUS DO NOT HAVE MUCH
23 SECURITY CAMERA COVERAGE TO DOCUMENT ANY ISSUES THAT
24 COULD ARISE; AND

25 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, NOT MUCH INFORMATION IS PRODUCED ON THE
26 LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY POLICE DEPARTMENT WEBSITE
27 ON RECENT PROGRESSION OF SECURITY CAMERA SYSTEMS; AND

28 **PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY RECENTLY APPLIED
29 FOR THE STANLEY SECURITY GRANT WHERE PORTIONS OF THE
30 POTENTIAL \$200,000 COULD GO TO RELIEVE SECURITY CAMERA
31 ISSUES.

32 **PARAGRAPH 7:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA
33 STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE URGE AND
34 REQUEST THAT THE LSU POLICE DEPARTMENT REEVALUATE
35 THEIR AMOUNT AND DISTRIBUTION OF SECURITY CAMERAS, AND

36 **PARAGRAPH 8:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS
37 RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO SERGEANT BUCKLAND
38 AND CAPTAIN WALTERS OF THE LSU POLICE DEPARTMENT.

39 **PARAGRAPH 9:** THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A
40 SIMPLE MAJORITY (ONE-HALF PLUS ONE) VOTE OF THE LSU
41 STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON
42 LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE
43 PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON
44 THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
