20 CREATE POSITIVE NATIONAL COVERAGE OF LOUISIANA STATE

23 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE DEBATE COULD RECRUIT POTENTIAL NEW
24 STUDENTS TO LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY.
