9 TO AMEND ARTICLE I OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY  
10 STUDENT GOVERNMENT TO INCLUDE AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CLAUSE.

13 PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE PURPOSE OF LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT IS TO  
14 PROVIDE SERVICE TO ALL STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY; AND

16 PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY PRACTICES A  
17 POLICY THAT PROVIDES EQUAL OPPORTUNITY TO ALL STUDENTS;  
18 AND

20 PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT, STRONGLY SUPPORTS  
21 AND PRACTICES THE PRINCIPLES OF EQUALITY, CIVILITY, AND  
22 RESPECT; AND

24 PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT WANTS TO REAFFIRM  
25 THESE PRINCIPLES THAT ARE ALREADY IN PRACTICE BY  
26 AMENDING ARTICLE I OF THE CONSTITUTION AS FOLLOWS:

27 SECTION 4. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY

28 IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE LSU STUDENT  
29 GOVERNMENT TO SERVE ALL LSU STUDENTS WITHOUT  
30 REGARD TO RACE, CREED, COLOR, MARITAL STATUS, SEXUAL  
31 ORIENTATION, GENDER IDENTITY, GENDER EXPRESSION,  
32 RELIGION, SEX, NATIONAL ORIGIN, AGE, MENTAL OR PHYSICAL  
33 DISABILITY, OR VETERAN'S STATUS

34 SECTION 4-5. GOVERNING STRUCTURE

39 PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA  
40 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND  
41 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT  
42 ARTICLE I OF THE LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT CONSTITUTION  
43 BE AMENDED TO INCLUDE AN EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CLAUSE.

45 PARAGRAPH 6: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS  
46 RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO K.C. WHITE, DEAN OF  
47 STUDENTS; AND CHAUNDA M. ALLEN, DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE  
48 OF MULTICULTURAL AFFAIRS.

50 PARAGRAPH 7: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS  
51 (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY  
52 THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL  
53 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY  
54 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
