12 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE LSU PLEDGE OF HONOR WAS ESTABLISHED TO
13 ENCOURAGE ACADEMIC INTEGRITY AMONG STUDENTS; AND

16 WITH PRIDE BY BOTH FACULTY AND STUDENTS; AND

19 VISIBLE TO ALL STUDENTS IN ALL AREAS OF THEIR ACADEMIC

- 34 COVER PAGE OF EVERY TEST
- 35 3. THE LSU PLEDGE OF HONOR COULD BE HANDED OUT ON
- 36 A SEPARATE PIECE OF PAPER TO BE SIGNED AND HANDED

43 INTEGRITY AND PRIDE AT LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY.


