8 **TO AMEND THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT BYLAWS**

9 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE TEMPORARY STUDENT GOVERNMENT
10 DOCUMENTS REVISION COMMITTEE WAS ESTABLISHED IN
11 SPRING 2013 TO REVIEW AND IMPROVE ALL GOVERNING
12 DOCUMENTS OF LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT, AND;

13 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, DISCREPANCIES HAVE TAKEN NOTE IN REGARD TO THE
14 DUE INSTALLATION AND OATH OF OFFICE OF THE STUDENT BODY
15 PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT IN COORDINATION WITH THE
16 SPRING ORGANIZATIONAL SESSION OF 2014; AND

17 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT BYLAWS SHALL BE
18 AMENDED AS FOLLOWS

19 **ARTICLE VII**

20 **Installation and Appointment Vacancies**

21 **Section 1. Due Installation and Oath of Office**

22 Elected members and University Court Justices shall be considered installed upon swearing in by
23 the Chief Justice of the University Court or his/her designee. All other members of the Student
24 Government shall be considered installed upon approval by the Student Senate.

25 A. The Student Body President and Vice President shall be installed during the annual
26 Student Senate Spring Organizational Session, ~~held at least~~ **at least** five (5) class days from the
27 ~~announcement of the final election results~~ **conclusion of the Spring Election Timetable**
28 ~~or any subsequently called Special Election,~~ **or any subsequently called Special Election,** but no more than ten (10) class days from
29 the last Student Senate meeting of the Spring Semester.

30 **PARAGRAPH 4:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA
31 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND
32 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT THESE
33 AMENDMENTS TO THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT BYLAWS
34 ARTICLE VII BE ADOPTED.

35 **PARAGRAPH 5:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS
36 (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY
37 THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL
38 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY
39 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
