**A FINANCE BILL**

TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF THIRTY-SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND  
ZERO CENTS (\$36,500.00) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES ACCOUNT  
TO FUND A CUSTOMIZED LSU EMERGENCY APPLICATION FOR SMART PHONES  
THROUGH THE LSU POLICE DEPARTMENT (LSU PD).

**PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE SAFETY OF LSU STUDENTS WHILE ON CAMPUS IS  
A VITAL CONCERN OF THE LSU POLICE DEPARTMENT AND  
STUDENT GOVERNMENT; AND

**PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, ON-CAMPUS SAFETY AMENITIES SUCH AS CALL BOXES  
AIM TO PROVIDE A DIRECT LINE OF COMMUNICATION BETWEEN A  
STUDENT IN DISTRESS AND LSU PD; AND

**PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, LSU PD HAS BEEN RESEARCHING A MORE EFFECTIVE  
WAY TO CONNECT WITH STUDENTS, FACULTY AND STAFF IN AN  
EMERGENCY SITUATION; AND

**PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, 87.6% OF LSU STUDENTS OWN SMARTPHONES  
ACCORDING TO THE NOVEMBER 2013 SURVEY CONDUCTED BY  
THE STUDENT TECHNOLOGY FEE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE; AND

**PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, EXTENSIVE RESEARCH HAS BEEN GATHERED ON AN  
EMERGENCY APPLICATION FOR DOWNLOAD ON SMART PHONES  
THAT HAS THE ABILITY TO DIRECTLY CONNECT A DISTRESSED  
INDIVIDUAL ON CAMPUS TO LSU PD WHILE PROVIDING REAL  
TIME GPS TRACKING OF THE INDIVIDUAL THROUGH THEIR  
MOBILE DEVICE; AND

**PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, LSU PD HAS RESEARCHED 52 SOFTWARE COMPANIES  
THAT PROVIDE SUCH AN APPLICATION. THEY HAVE DETERMINED  
THAT THE COMPANY 911 CELLULAR SOFTWARE SYSTEM CAN  
PROVIDE AN APPLICATION TO LSU WITH ALL OF THE DESIRED  
FUNCTIONS (LISTED IN PARAGRAPH 7) FOR THE BEST POSSIBLE  
VALUE SUBSCRIPTION COST; AND

**PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, KEY FEATURES OF THE SOFTWARE OFFERED BY 911  
CELLULAR INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- ONE TOUCH, IMMEDIATE EMERGENCY CONNECTION WITH  
LSU PD VIA A PANIC BUTTON
- GPS TRACKING OF A MOBILE DEVICE ACTIVATED IN AN  
EMERGENCY
- EMERGENCY CONNECTION THAT ALSO INCLUDES FIRE AND  
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES (EMS)

- INDIVIDUAL USER PROFILE INFORMATION THAT CAN BE ACCESSED BY EMERGENCY PERSONNEL INCLUDING DEMOGRAPHICS, EMERGENCY CONTACTS, MEDICAL CONDITIONS, ALLERGIES, BLOOD TYPE, AND MORE
- GEO-FENCING THAT ALLOWS THE APP TO DETERMINE IF THE USER IS ON CAMPUS OR NOT. IF NOT, THE CONNECTION IS ROUTED TO THE RESPECTIVE 911 DISPATCH
- NON-EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION WITH CAMPUS POLICE INCLUDING TWO-WAY TEXT MESSAGING AND ABILITY TO SEND PICTURES AND VIDEOS FOR EVIDENCE
- DESKTOP PANIC BUTTONS FOR ON-CAMPUS COMPUTERS (IN CLASSROOMS, OFFICES AND LABS) THAT CONNECT USERS TO LSU PD
- LSU SYSTEM-WIDE USE
- FREE DOWNLOAD FOR USERS
- ABILITY FOR CAMPUS VISITORS, PARENTS, AND ANY NON-LSU STUDENT, STAFF OR FACULTY TO DOWNLOAD
- ABILITY TO ROUTE LSU EMERGENCY TEXT MESSAGES THROUGH THE APPLICATION; AND

**PARAGRAPH 8:** WHEREAS, 911 CELLULAR HAS PROVIDED AN EXTREMELY SUCCESSFUL TRIAL RUN OF THE APPLICATION WITH LSU PD EARLIER THIS SEMESTER; AND

**PARAGRAPH 9:** WHEREAS, LSU PD WOULD LIKE TO MOVE FORWARD WITH THE LICENSE AGREEMENT AND IMPLEMENT THIS APPLICATION AND SOFTWARE AT LSU; AND

**PARAGRAPH 10:** WHEREAS, THE FOLLOWING ARE COSTS OF IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SOFTWARE AT LSU FOR THE NEXT THREE YEARS

- YEAR 1:
  - YEARLY LICENSE FEE..... \$24,000
  - ONE TIME HARDWARE FEE.....\$15,750
  - ONE TIME NETWORK INTEGRATION FEE.....\$ 3,800
  - **TOTAL.....\$43,550**
- YEAR 2:
  - **YEARLY LICENSE FEE.....\$25,200**
- YEAR 3:
  - **YEARLY LICENSE FEE.....\$26,400**

**PARAGRAPH 11:** WHEREAS, THIS FINANCE BILL SHALL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING FUNDING FOR THE FIRST YEAR TO IMPLEMENT THIS SOFTWARE

- 107 • YEAR 1 YEARLY LICENSE FEE..... 24,000 X 69.2%\* = 16,608
- 108 • ONE TIME HARDWARE FEE.....15,750 X 100%= 15,750
- 109 • ONE TIME NETWORK INTEGRATION FEE... 3,800 X 100% = 3,800
- 110 • **TOTAL FUNDING FROM FINANCE BILL..... = 36,158**

 112 \*69.2% IS BASED ON THE % OF LSU A&M STUDENTS IN THE LSU  
 113 SYSTEM. THE ONE TIME HARDWARE FEE AND NETWORK  
 114 INTEGRATION FEES ARE DIRECTLY ASSOCIATED WITH LSU A&M.

116 **PARAGRAPH 12:** WHEREAS, IT IS HOPEFUL THAT THIS APPLICATION WILL BE  
 117 READY FOR USE BY FALL 2014.

119 **PARAGRAPH 13:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA  
 120 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND  
 121 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT A  
 122 MAXIMUM OF THIRTY-SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS  
 123 AND ZERO CENTS (\$36,500.00) IS ALLOCATED FROM THE STUDENT  
 124 GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO FUND A CUSTOMIZED  
 125 LSU EMERGENCY APPLICATION FOR SMART PHONES THROUGH  
 126 THE LSU POLICE DEPARTMENT.

128 **PARAGRAPH 14:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS  
 129 (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY  
 130 THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL  
 131 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY  
 132 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
