A RESOLUTION

TO THANK THE GOVERNOR OF LOUISIANA AND THE MEMBERS OF THE LOUISIANA STATE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES FOR THEIR SUPPORT OF FUNDING *LE CONSEIL POUR LE DÉVELOPPEMENT DU FRANÇAIS EN LOUISIANE (CODOFIL)* AND ITS PRESERVATION AND PROMOTION OF LOUISIANA'S CULTURAL LANGUAGES

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE COUNCIL FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF FRENCH IN LOUISIANA (CODOFIL), *LE CONSEIL POUR LE DÉVELOPPEMENT DU FRANÇAIS EN LOUISIANE*, IS LOUISIANA'S OFFICE OF FRANCOPHONE AFFAIRS, *AGENCE DES AFFAIRES FRANCOPHONES*, A STATE AGENCY WHOSE MULTIPLE LEGISLATIVE MANDATES INCLUDE DEVELOPING OPPORTUNITIES TO USE THE FRENCH LANGUAGE IN TOURISM, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, CULTURE, EDUCATION AND INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS, AND;

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, CODOFIL'S MISSION IS TO "WORK TOWARD THE CREATION OF AN ECO-SYSTEM THAT PERMITS THE DEVELOPMENT OF FRENCH IN THE ECONOMIC, EDUCATIONAL, CULTURAL AND PROFESSIONAL SECTORS AND IN WHICH LOUISIANA'S FRENCH AND CREOLE SPEAKERS ARE VALORIZED IN THEIR CULTURAL AND LINGUISTIC IDENTITY." IT SEEKS TO "PROVIDE ACCESS TO ECONOMIC, EDUCATIONAL, CULTURAL AND PROFESSIONAL OPPORTUNITIES IN FRENCH TO ALL LOUISIANIANS," AND;

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, CODOFIL WAS CREATED BY ACT OF THE STATE LEGISLATURE IN 1968 BECAUSE OF THE VAST NUMBER OF FRENCH-SPEAKING LOUISIANA CITIZENS, AND;

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, SINCE ITS INCEPTION, CODOFIL HAS HELPED TO PLACE HUNDREDS OF EDUCATORS FROM FRANCE, CANADA, BELGIUM AND ELSEWHERE IN *LA FRANCOPHONIE* INTO THE LANGUAGE IMMERSION

PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, TODAY, LOUISIANA STUDENTS BENEFIT FROM THE OPPORTUNITIES TO BETTER THEIR KNOWLEDGE OF LOUISIANA'S FRENCH HERITAGE THROUGH *FRANCO-RESPONSABLE* INTERACTIONS AND STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED BY CODOFIL, AND;

PARAGRAPH 6: WHEREAS, ARTICLE XII § 4 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF LOUISIANA (1974) STATES: "THE RIGHT OF THE PEOPLE TO PRESERVE, FOSTER, AND PROMOTE THEIR RESPECTIVE HISTORIC LINGUISTIC AND CULTURAL ORIGINS IS RECOGNIZED." AND;

PARAGRAPH 7: WHEREAS, LOUISIANA'S REVISED STATUTES (43:204) STATES: "WHEN ADVERTISEMENTS ARE REQUIRED TO BE MADE IN RELATION TO JUDICIAL PROCESS, OR IN THE SALE OF PROPERTY FOR UNPAID TAXES, OR UNDER JUDICIAL PROCESS OR ANY OTHER LEGAL PROCESS OF WHATEVER KIND, THEY SHALL BE MADE IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND MAY IN ADDITION BE DUPLICATED IN THE FRENCH LANGUAGE. STATE AND LOCAL OFFICIALS AND PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS ARE RECONFIRMED IN THE TRADITIONAL RIGHT TO PUBLISH DOCUMENTS IN THE FRENCH LANGUAGE IN ADDITION TO ENGLISH.", AND;

PARAGRAPH 8: WHEREAS, CODOFIL WILL RECEIVE \$150,000 IN STATE GENERAL FUND MONEY THROUGH THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2015, BRINGING THE TOTAL FUNDING FOR CODOFIL UP TO \$301,854 THANKS TO THE SUPPORT OF GOV. PIYUSH "BOBBY" JINDAL AND THE STATE LEGISLATURE, AND;

PARAGRAPH 9: WHEREAS, LACHE-PAS LA POTATE.
