9 A RESOLUTION

10 TO URGE AND REQUEST LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY (LSU) ATHLETICS AND  
11 FESTIVAL AND EVENT STAFFING AND SECURITY SERVICES, INC. (FESS) TO EXPLORE  
12 OPTIONS FOR COLLECTING PROHIBITED ITEMS THROUGH ATHLETIC ENTRY GATES.

15 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE TIGER STADIUM IN-STADIUM POLICY  
16 CURRENTLY RESTRICTS THE FOLLOWING ITEMS FROM BEING  
17 BROUGHT INTO THE STADIUM: COOLERS, ICE CHESTS, BOTTLES,  
18 CANS, CUPS, BACKPACKS OR BAGS LARGER THAN 8 1/2" X 11,"  
19 UMBRELLAS, ANY TYPE OF ARTIFICIAL NOISE MAKERS, VIDEO  
20 CAMERAS, WEAPONS OF ANY KIND – INCLUDING POCKET KNIVES  
21 AND MULTI-TOOLS, BANNERS, FLAGS, POLES OF ANY KIND, AND;

23 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THESE ITEMS ARE CONFISCATED AND DISCARDED AT  
24 THE ENTRY GATES IF FOUND, AND;

25  
26 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, AN OPTION TO CHECK IN RESTRICTED ITEMS SUCH AS:  
27 COOLERS, BACKPACKS, UMBRELLAS, VIDEO CAMERAS, POCKET  
28 KNIVES WOULD BENEFIT MANY LSU ATHLETICS PATRONS, AND;

29  
30 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, PERTAINING TO LOCATION, THESE CHECK-INS COULD  
31 BE DISPERSED BY THE ENTRY GATES AROUND THE STADIUM, AND;

33 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, AN ADDITIONAL SOLUTION COULD BE TO DONATE THE  
34 CONFISCATED ITEMS TO A LOCAL CHARITY OF THRIFT STORE  
35 RATHER THAN DISCARDING THESE ITEMS, OR PARTNER UP WITH  
36 THE CURRENT LOST AND FOUND SYSTEM ASSOCIATED WITH THE  
37 LSU POLICE DEPARTMENT.

39 **PARAGRAPH 6:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA  
40 STATE UNIVERSITY COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT  
41 LSU ATHLETICS S LOOK INTO ITEM CHECK-INS FOR STADIUM  
42 ENTRY GATES, AND

44 **PARAGRAPH 7:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS  
45 RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO RONNIE HALIBURTON,  
46 SR. ASSOC. ATHLETIC DIRECTOR OF FACILITIES AND GROUNDS  
47 AND TODD JEANSONNE, DIRECTOR OF FACILITIES AND GROUNDS

49 **PARAGRAPH 8:** THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A  
50 SIMPLE MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE  
51 AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR  
52 PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND  
53 SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF  
54 SUCH APPROVAL.
