10 **TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS**
11 **(\$3,000.00) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT LEGISLATIVE GENERAL**
12 **CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND**
13 **MECHANICAL COLLEGE (LSU) INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ASSOCIATION (ISA) FOR**

16 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THERE IS ABOUT ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED
17 (1,700) INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS REGISTERED AT LSU IN THE
18 SPRING SEMESTER OF 2013, AND;

20 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE ISA AT LSU REPRESENTS ALL INTERNATIONAL
21 STUDENTS BY: INITIATING FUNDRAISING EFFORTS, ARRANGING
22 CULTURAL PERFORMANCES OR PRESENTATIONS, AND
23 ADVOCATING THE NEEDS FOR THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY,

26 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE ISA ACCOMPLISHES THESE GOALS BY ORGANIZING
27 IN APRIL, SINCE 2011, A CELEBRATORY DAY OF CULTURAL
28 EXHIBITIONS, CULINARY SAMPLES, AND ARTISTIC PERFORMANCES
29 FROM AROUND THE WORLD CALLED THE “INTERNATIONAL
