11 **TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS AND ZERO**

16 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE VISION OF THE GLOBAL BRIGADES MEDICAL
17 CHAPTER AT LSU IS TO IMPROVE EQUALITY OF LIFE BY IGNITING
18 THE LARGEST STUDENT-LED SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY MOVEMENT
19 ON THE PLANET, AND;

21 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THEIR MISSION IS TO RESOLVE GLOBAL HEALTH AND
22 ECONOMIC DISPARITIES BY EMPOWERING STUDENT VOLUNTEERS,
23 LOCAL PROFESSIONALS, AND COMMUNITY MEMBERS IN A
24 COLLABORATIVE HOLISTIC APPROACH TO SUSTAINABLE
25 DEVELOPMENT, AND;

27 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ALLOCATIONS WILL GO
28 TOWARD THE ONE WEEK MEDICAL BRIGADE TO HONDURAS
29 WHERE VOLUNTEERS WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO MAKE A
30 TANGIBLE IMPACT ON COMMUNITIES WHILE GAINING REAL LIFE
31 EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD OF INTERNATIONAL MEDICINE, AND;

33 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE GLOBAL BRIGADES MEDICAL CHAPTER AT LSU IS
34 A NON-PROFIT STUDENT LED ORGANIZATION AND IS RESPONSIBLE
35 FOR PURCHASING THE MEDICATIONS, DENTAL PACKS, AND MUST
36 HIRE A DOCTOR AND DENTIST TO ACCOMPANY THEM ON THE

39 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THIS EXPENDITURE WOULD COVER THE FOLLOWING
40 ACQUISITIONS:

- 41 1. DENTIST SERVICE FEE (\$100 PER DAY/5 DAYS) \$500.00
42 2. DOCTOR SERVICES FEE (\$75 PER DAY/5 DAYS) \$375.00
43 3. MEDICATION EXPENSES (\$1,725.00)

45 **PARAGRAPH 6:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA
46 STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND
47 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE TO ALLOCATE
48 A MAXIMUM OF TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS AND
49 ZERO CENTS (\$2,600.00) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT
50 LEGISLATIVE GENERAL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE
51 GLOBAL BRIGADES MEDICAL CHAPTER AT LOUISIANA STATE
52 UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE

54 **PARAGRAPH 7:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS
55 (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY

THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL
ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY
APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
