9 **TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4000.00) FROM THE**  
10 **STUDENT GOVERNMENT CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE GREEK BOARD OF**  
11 **DIRECTORS (GBOD) EMPOWER LEADERSHIP PROGRAM**

14 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, DURING THE SPRING SEMESTER, FIRST YEAR GREEK  
15 STUDENTS HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO ATTEND A WEEKEND  
16 LONG LEADERSHIP RETREAT OFF CAMPUS; AND

18 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE FOCUS OF THE PROGRAM IS: IDENTIFYING  
19 STRENGTHS, INDIVIDUAL LIMITATIONS, DEVELOPING  
20 LEADERSHIP, COMMUNICATION SKILLS, EXPLORING PERSONAL  
21 VALUES, STRENGTH OF PERSONAL CONVICTIONS, AND MAKING A  
22 COMMITMENT TO FRATERNAL IDEAS; AND

24 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE EMPOWER LEADERSHIP PROGRAM PROVIDES  
25 AN IMMERSED LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT TRAINING  
26 OPPORTUNITY FOR OVER 144 GREEK AFFILIATED STUDENTS  
27 EVERY YEAR FOR THE LAST 12 YEARS; AND

29 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, GBOD CURRENTLY WORKS WITH OVER 4500  
30 STUDENTS IN 39 DIFFERENT ORGANIZATIONS; AND

32 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, EMPOWER IS ONE OF THE LARGEST PROGRAMS  
33 GBOD HOSTS; AND

35 **PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, THE PARTICIPANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR FUNDING A  
36 ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY DOLLAR (\$135.00) REGISTRATION  
37 FEE; AND

39 **PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, GBOD HAS ACTIVELY PURSUED FUNDING FROM  
40 VARIOUS BATON ROUGE BUSINESS; AND

42 **PARAGRAPH 8:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA  
43 STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND  
44 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT FOUR  
45 THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4000) BE ALLOCATED FROM THE STUDENT  
46 GOVERNMENT CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE GREEK  
47 BOARD OF DIRECTORS (GBOD) EMPOWER LEADERSHIP  
48 PROGRAM; AND

50 **PARAGRAPH 9:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS  
51 (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY  
52 THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL  
53 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY  
54 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
