FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 15–09

A Committee to Consider the Maximum Number of Midterm Examinations per Day

Introduced at the request of Student Government

Whereas LSU Student Government has passed a resolution requesting that LSU establish a policy regarding the maximum number of midterm examinations that a student may be required to take in a single day;

Therefore be it resolved that the Faculty Senate form a committee comprised of faculty senate members, student government representatives, and administrators to consider the feasibility of capping the number of any kind of mid-term assessment that a student must take in any one day.
