A FINANCE BILL

**TO ALLOCATE FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4000) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT
CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE GREEK BOARD OF DIRECTORS (GBOD)
EMPOWER LEADERSHIP PROGRAM**

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE EMPOWER LEADERSHIP PROGRAM PROVIDES A LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITY FOR OVER 120 STUDENTS EVERY YEAR FOR THE LAST 12 YEARS; AND
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE MAIN FOCUS OF THE PROGRAM IS IDENTIFYING STRENGTHS AND LIMITATIONS, DEVELOPING LEADERSHIP AND COMMUNICATION SKILLS, EXPLORING PERSONAL VALUES AND STRENGTH OF CONVICTION, AND MAKING A COMMITMENT TO FRATERNAL IDEAS; AND
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, GBOD CURRENTLY WORKS WITH 4500 STUDENTS IN 38 DIFFERENT ORGANIZATIONS; AND
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, EMPOWER IS ONE OF THE LARGEST PROGRAMS GBOD HOSTS; AND
- PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, MANY OF LSU'S STUDENT ORGANIZATION LEADERS HAVE ATTENDED THIS PROGRAM IN THE PAST; AND
- PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, THE PARTICIPANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR FUNDING A ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY DOLLAR (\$130) FEE; AND
- PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, GBOD HAS BEEN AWARDED TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2000) IN SPONSORSHIP BY ASPEN HEIGHTS; AND
- PARAGRAPH 8:** WHEREAS, THE COMPLETE PROGRAM BUDGET WILL BE ATTACHED TO THIS BILL;
- PARAGRAPH 9:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4000) BE ALLOCATED FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE GREEK BOARD OF DIRECTORS (GBOD) EMPOWER LEADERSHIP PROGRAM; AND
- PARAGRAPH 10:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
