A FINANCE BILL

TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF \$1,620.00 OF THE STUDENT SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE INTERCOLLEGIATE STUDIES INSTITUTE AT LSU FOR PROGRAM EXPENSES FOR A SPEAKER EVENT HOSTING PROFESSOR CAPALDI ON APRIL 24TH, 2012 AT 3PM IN HILL MEMORIAL LIBRARY

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE INTERCOLLEGIATE STUDIES INSTITUTE AT LSU IS DEVOTED TO DISCUSSING AND PROMOTING THE PRINCIPLES OF LIBERAL EDUCATION, AND IN DOING SO THE ORGANIZATION SEEKS TO PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR DIALOGUE AMONG STUDENTS REGARDING QUESTIONS SURROUNDING LIBERTY IN AMERICAN POLITICAL, ECONOMIC, AND SOCIAL LIFE, AND;

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, GIVEN THE CURRENT FINANCIAL CRISES, THE RECENT PROTESTS AGAINST WALL STREET AND BIG BUSINESS, THE DISCUSSION SURROUNDING THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN BUSINESS AND GOVERNMENT AMIDST THE REPUBLICAN PRIMARIES, AMONG OTHER THINGS, A LECTURE ON ETHICS AND CAPITALISM SEEMS A MOST APPROPRIATE AND WELCOME EVENT, AND;

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE EXPENDITURE WOULD COVER THE FOLLOWING:

1. HONORARIUM FOR PUBLIC LECTURE - \$1,000
2. HILL MEMORIAL LECTURE HALL RENTAL - \$45 (1.5HRS W/ REFRESHMENT CLEAN UP)
3. POSTERS - \$360
4. RECEPTION - \$215 (4 DOZ. ICED BROWNIES (\$12.95/DOZ))
 - a. 4 DOZ. GOURMET COOKIES (\$7.95/DOZ)
 - b. 1 LB MIXED NUTS (\$8.95)
 - c. 2 GAL COFFEE (\$19.95/GAL)
 - d. 2 GAL LEMONADE (\$14.95/GAL)
 - e. DELIVERY AND GRATUITY, AND;

PARAGRAPH 4: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED AND TWENTY (1,620.00) DOLLARS IS ALLOCATED FROM THE STUDENT SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FOR EXPENSES RELATING TO THE HOSTING OF PROFESSOR CAPALDI, AND;

PARAGRAPH 5: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL

ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
