A FINANCE BILL

TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT SUPPORTING THE NEW AWARENESS CAMPAIGN OF CAMD (CENTER FOR ADVANCED MICROSTRUCTURE DEVICES).

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE SGR No. 10 OUTLINED A NEW PLAN OF ACTION TO PROMOTE CAMD TO BOTH STUDENTS AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC THROUGH A NEW AWARENESS CAMPAIGN AND;

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, IN ORDER TO AID CAMD IN STARTING THIS NEW AWARENESS CAMPAIGN FUNDS WILL BE USED FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT, AND;

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE FUNDS ALLOCATED TO CAMD WILL BE GOVERNED BY A AD HOC COMMITTEE BY THE CENTER FOR ADVANCED MICROSTRUCTURE DEVICES WITH STUDENT GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATION, AND;

PARAGRAPH 4: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT A MAXIMUM OF TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO SUPPORTING THE NEW AWARENESS CAMPAIGN OF CAMD (CENTER FOR ADVANCED MICROSTRUCTURE DEVICES).

PARAGRAPH 5: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
