A RESOLUTION

TO URGE AND REQUEST THE OFFICE OF PARKING, TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORTATION TO EXTEND THE HOURS OF CAMPUS TRANSIT DURING FINALS WEEKS.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, DURING FINALS WEEKS, MOST STUDENTS KEEP LATER HOURS THAN NORMAL FOR STUDYING AND;

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, STUDENTS SHOULD HAVE THE SAFER OPTION TO TAKE CAMPUS TRANSIT TO AND FROM STUDY AREAS TO GO TO THEIR ROOMS LATE AT NIGHT INSTEAD OF HAVING TO WALK AND;

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, ONE BUS WOULD BE SUFFICIENT TO COVER THE EARLY MORNING HOURS UNTIL TIGER TRAILS STARTS UP AGAIN AND;

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THIS WOULD POTENTIALLY MAKE IT EASIER FOR THOSE WHO STAY UP LATE STUDYING AND DO NOT FEEL SAFE WALKING BACK TO THEIR RESIDENCE HALLS OR VEHICLES.

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT THE OFFICE OF PARKING, TRAFFIC, AND TRANSPORTATION EXTEND THE HOURS OF CAMPUS TRANSIT DURING FINALS WEEK.

PARAGRAPH 6: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO GARY GRAHAM, DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF PARKING, TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORTATION.

PARAGRAPH 7: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
