A RESOLUTION

TO URGE AND REQUEST THE LOUISIANA LEGISLATURE TO PASS HOUSE BILL NO. 407,
THE BULLYING PREVENTION ACT

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE CURRENT ANTI-BULLYING LAW IS VAGUE AND INSUFFICIENT IN PROTECTING LOUISIANA STUDENTS AND;

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE CURRENT LAW DOES NOT PROTECT STUDENTS FROM BULLYING BY SCHOOL EMPLOYERS OR VICE-VERSA AND;

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE BULLYING PREVENTION ACT SPECIFICALLY ENUMERATES PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS WHICH ARE OFTEN THE MOTIVATION FOR HARASSMENT, SUCH AS: RACE, RELIGION, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, PHYSICAL, MENTAL, OR DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AMONG OTHERS AND;

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THIS ACT WILL ALSO PROTECT STUDENTS FROM SCHOOL EMPLOYMENT HARASSMENT AND VICE-VERSA;

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT THE LOUISIANA LEGISLATURE PASS HOUSE BILL NO. 407, THE BULLYING PREVENTION ACT, AND A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE SENT TO EVERY MEMBER OF THE LOUISIANA LEGISLATURE

PARAGRAPH 6: THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
