A RESOLUTION

TO OFFICIALLY SUPPORT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMPREHENSIVE ACADEMIC TRACKING SYSTEM (CATS)

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY HAS BEGUN A PILOT PROGRAM FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE ACADEMIC TRACKING SYSTEM (CATS); AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE AIM OF THIS PROGRAM IS TO ASSIST STUDENTS IN STAYING ON TRACK TOWARD TIMELY GRADUATION; AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS PROGRAM WOULD LIKELY INCREASE THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS THAT GRADUATE IN FOUR YEARS.

PARAGRAPH 4: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE OFFICIALLY SUPPORTS THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMPREHENSIVE ACADEMIC TRACKING SYSTEM (CATS); AND

PARAGRAPH 5: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A SUITABLE COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE FORWARDED TO ALL OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COMPREHENSIVE ACADEMIC TRACKING SYSTEM COMMITTEE, AS WELL AS DR. ASTRID MERGET, EXECUTIVE VICE CHANCELLOR AND PROVOST

PARAGRAPH 6: THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT; UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION; OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE.
