A RESOLUTION

TO OFFICIALLY URGE THE LOUISIANA COUNSEL OF STUDENT BODY PRESIDENTS (COSP) NOT TO PASS A RESOLUTION REGARDING CONCEALED CARRYING ON CAMPUS.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE COUNSEL OF STUDENT BODY PRESIDENTS IS A COUNSEL DESIGNED TO REPRESENT ALL THE STUDENTS IN THE STATE OF LOUISIANA; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE COLLABORATION OF ALL THE STUDENT BODY PRESIDENTS IS BENEFICIAL TO ALL STUDENTS IN LOUISIANA; AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THEY SHOULD NOT, THOUGH, COMMENT ON CONTROVERSIAL MATTERS, BECAUSE IN THESE MATTERS THEY DO NOT NECESSARILY REPRESENT THE OPINIONS OF A MAJORITY OF THE STUDENTS IN LOUISIANA.

PARAGRAPH 4: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE THAT WE URGE COSP NOT TO PASS A BILL REGARDING HOUSE BILL NO 27

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS BILL BE SENT TO ALL MEMEBERS OF COSP.

PARAGRAPH 6: THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
