A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE TWELVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1200) FROM THE FUNDS OF THE STUDENT SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE GEOGRAPHY AND ANTHROPOLOGY SOCIETY'S "TRAVELERS' TALES SPEAKERS SERIES"

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, TRAVELERS' TALES PROVIDES AN OUTLET FOR STUDENTS AND FACULTY WHO TRAVEL ABOARD TO SHARE THEIR MEMORIES, STORIES AND DISCOVERIES WITH OTHER STUDENTS; AND,

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, this forum represents the essence of geography and a real return to the roots of the discipline which are leaving the familiar, going to a foreign place and returning home to share news of the similarities and differences; and,


PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THROUGH PHOTOGRAPHS, MUSIC, STORIES, AND SOUVENIRS THE SPEAKERS BRING THEIR AUDIENCE BRIEFLY INTO THE PLACES OF THEIR TRAVELS, AND,

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THESE EVENTS WILL TAKE PLACE DURING THE SPRING SEMESTER AND ARE OPEN TO ALL STUDENTS, FACULTY, STAFF AND COMMUNITY MEMBERS,

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT SENATE OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE THAT THE AMOUNT TWELVE-HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1200) BE ALLOCATED FROM THE STUDENT SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FOR PAYMENT ON EXPENSES TO BE INCURRED FOR THE GEOGRAPHY AND ANTHROPOLOGY SOCIETY'S "TRAVELERS' TALES SPEAKERS SERIES"


PARAGRAPH 6: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A THREE-FOURTHS VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
