A BILL

TO ALLOCATE TEN THOUSAND(\$10,000) DOLLARS OF THE STUDENT SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE COMMUNICATIONS STUDIES DEPARTMENT TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF PARTICIPATION IN NATIONAL QUALIFYING TOURNAMENTS FOR THE MIXON LYCEUM DEBATE TEAM

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE MIXON LYCEUM SPEECH & DEBATE TEAM IS CURRENTLY COMPETITIVE AND NATIONALLY RANKED DESPITE A LACK OF FUNDING, AND IN ORDER TO ENSURE QUALIFICATION FOR NATIONALS EACH MEMBER MUST ATTEND AND QUALIFY AT THREE NATIONAL QUALIFYING TOURNAMENTS, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE MIXON LYCEUM SPEECH & DEBATE TEM, DUE TO LACK OF FUNDING, DOESN'T HAVE THE ABILITY TO ATTEND THE NECESSARY AMOUNT OF NATIONAL TOURNAMENTS TO BE COMPETITIVE, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THIS MONEY IS NOT INTENDED TO BE ALLOCATED FOR ONE SPECIFIC TOURNAMENT BUT INSTEAD ALLOCATED FOR TOURNAMENTS TO BE HELD IN CALIFORNIA, COLORADO, AND TENNESSEE, AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THE MIXON LYCEUM SPEECH & DEBATE TEAM WILL REPRESENT THE UNIVERSITY IN A POSITIVE MANNER ON THE NATIONAL STAGE, AND FURTHER THE FLAGSHIP AGENDA

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000) BE ALLOCATED FROM THE SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE COMMUNICATION STUDIES DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE NATIONAL QUALIFYING TOURNAMENTS FOR THE MIXON LYCEUM DEBATE TEAM.

PARAGRAPH 6: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A 3/4 (THREE-FOURTHS) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
