10 **SENATE CONTINGENCY TO HELP WITH COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE STUDENT**
11 **FINANCE ASSOCIATION TRIP TO NEW YORK CITY ON MARCH 21ST - APRIL 4TH.**

14 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE STUDENT FINANCE ASSOCIATION OF THE
15 E.J. OURSO COLLEGE OF BUSINEES WILL BE TRAVELLING TO NEW
16 YORK CITY TO VISIT INVESTMENT BANKS AND OTHER FINANCAL
17 SERVICE PROFESSIONALS; AND

19 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, NEW YORK CITY IS THE PINNACLE OF THE UNITED
20 STATES FINANCIAL COMMUNITY, AND LSU SUDENTS OFTEN HAVE
21 LITTLE EXPOSURE TO THOSE WORKING IN THE FINANCIAL SECTOR
22 BESIDES THAT OF RETAIL BANKING AND BROKERAGE SERVICES;

25 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, NEW YORK CITY WAS THE HOME TO THE LAUNCH OF
26 THE FOREVER LSU ENDOWMENT CAMPAIGN, AND THE TRIP WILL
27 HELP LSU FORGE GREATER RELATIONSHIPS WITH NEW
28 YORK BUSINESSES FOR ENDOWMENT AND CAREER PURPOSES; AND

30 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THERE IS A NEED TO FUND SUCH INITIATIVES AS IT
31 WILL REPRESENT THE UNIVERSITY IN A POSITIVE MANNER ON THE
32 NATIONAL STAGE, AND ENRICH THE LEVEL OF EDUCATION FOR
33 THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN THE TRIP;

36 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, IN KEEPING WITH THE UNIVERSITY’S FLAGSHIP
37 AGENDA AND EXPAND THE LEVEL RESEARCH, THERE IS A NEED TO
38 CONTINUE TO FUND ATTENDANCE AT CONFERENCES; AND

40 **PARAGRAPH 6:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT
41 SENATE OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY
42 AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE THAT
43 THE AMOUNT OF ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$1,500)
44 DOLLARS BE ALLOCATED FOR THE PURPOSES OF HOUSING AND
45 TRANSPORTATION FROM THE STUDENT SENATE CONTINGENCY
46 FOR EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE STUDENT FINANCE
47 ASSOCIATION TRIP TO NEW YORK, NEW YORK.

49 **PARAGRAPH 7:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS
50 (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY
51 THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL
52 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY
53 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
