7 **A RESOLUTION**

8 **TO CREATE THE TEMPORARY ELECTION CODE REVISION COMMITTEE**

9 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT IS THE GOVERNING  
10 BODY OF THE LSU STUDENT BODY, AND

11 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, CANDIDATES AS WELL AS TICKETS MUST FOLLOW THE  
12 ELECTION CODE, AND

13 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE ELECTION CODE IS IN NEED OF REVISIONS AND  
14 REVIEW, AND

15 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, IT IS IMPORTANT THAT THESE CANDIDATES BE HELD  
16 TO THE HIGHEST OF STANDARDS WHICH SHOULD BE CLEARLY  
17 LAID OUT, AND

18 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THE COMMITTEE SHALL REVIEW AND OFFER REVISION  
19 TO THE ELECTION CODE IN THE FORM OF LEGISLATION, AND

20 **PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, THE SENATE HAS THE ABILITY TO CREATE SUCH  
21 TEMPORARY COMMITTEES, AND

22 **PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, ALL RULES FOR THE ELECTION CODE REVISION  
23 COMMITTEE SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:

- 24 **a.** ALL MEETINGS MUST BE HELD BETWEEN JULY FIRST (1) AND JULY  
25 TWENTY-FIRST (21), SO THAT ALL LEGISLATION SHALL HAVE DUE TIME  
26 TO NOT ONLY BE CONSTRUCTED BUT REVISED IF NECESSARY BEFORE  
27 BEING BROUGHT TO THE SENATE BODY
- 28 **b.** MEETINGS MUST BE HELD IN AN OPEN, PUBLIC FORUM EITHER AT OR  
29 WITHIN A TEN (10) MILE RADIUS FROM THE UNIVERSITY'S CAMPUS
- 30 **c.** ANY MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO BRING  
31 FORTH LEGISLATION WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ALL EX-OFFICIO MEMBERS
- 32 **d.** ALL LEGISLATION REQUIRES A MAJORITY VOTE BY THE COMMITTEE IN  
33 ORDER TO BE BROUGHT TO THE SENATE
- 34 **e.** MEMBERS NECESSARY SHALL CONSIST OF THOSE MENTIONED IN  
35 PARAGRAPH (9). QUORUM SHALL CONSIST OF A TWO-THIRDS (2/3)  
36 PRESENCE OF ALL MEMBERS MENTIONED BELOW, NOT INCLUDING ALL EX-  
37 OFFICIO MEMBERS

38 **PARAGRAPH 8:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT  
39 GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY  
40 AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE  
41 HEREBY CREATES THE TEMPORARY ELECTION CODE  
42 REVISION COMMITTEE,

55 **PARAGRAPH 9:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS COMMITTEE  
56 SHALL CONSIST OF FOUR (4) SENATORS ELECTED  
57 DURING THE SPRING ORGANIZATIONAL SESSION,  
58 CHIEF JUSTICE, SOLICITOR GENERAL AND ONE  
59 ELECTED MEMBER OF THE JUDICIAL BRANCH, THE  
60 COMMISSIONER OF ELECTIONS, THE PRESIDENT OR  
61 VICE-PRESIDENT AND A MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE  
62 STAFF AS SELECTED BY THE PRESIDENT,  
63

64 **PARAGRAPH 10:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT ONE (1) SENATOR  
65 SHALL SERVE AS CHAIRMAN UPON FORMATION OF  
66 THE COMMITTEE  
67

68 **PARAGRAPH 11:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A THREE-  
69 FOURTHS VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE  
70 BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL  
71 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY  
72 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
