10 **TO CREATE A CAMPUS BUS ROUTE TASK FORCE AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED**
11 **MATTERS**

13 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE CURRENT BUS SYSTEM IS A TOP COMPLAINT
14 AMONGST STUDENTS, AS THE BUSES ARE OFTEN DELAYED FAR
15 BEYOND THEIR NORMAL SCHEDULED TIMES, AND

16 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE CAMPUS MASTER PLAN CALLS FOR THE
17 RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC ON CAMPUS BEGINNING IN
18 THE SPRING OF 2007, AND

19 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, CLOSING OFF THE CAMPUS WILL BE BENEFICIAL TO BUS
20 TRAFFIC, BUT NOT NECESSARILY TO TIME CONSTRAINTS
21 CONCERNING SUCH, AND

22 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, RECOGNIZING THE NEED AND NECESSITY OF THE
23 LSU STUDENT SENATE TO STUDY AND SUPPORT COMPLAINTS
24 BROUGHT ABOUT BY LSU STUDENTS;

25 **PARAGRAPH 5:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT
26 GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY
27 AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE TO
28 CREATE THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY CAMPUS BUS ROUTE
29 TASK FORCE, AND

31 **PARAGRAPH 6:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS COMMISSION SHALL
32 CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

- 34 1. THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT DIRECTOR OF STUDENT
- 35 SERVICES OR THE EQUIVALENT POSITION, AND
- 36 2. TWO (2) MEMBERS OF THE STUDENT SENATE HOUSING,
- 37 INFORMATION, AND TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE TO BE
- 38 SELECTED BY THE HIT COMMITTEE CHAIR, AND
- 39 3. TWO (2) MEMBERS OF THE STUDENT SENATE COMMITTEE
- 40 ON STUDENTS RIGHTS AND WELFARE TO BE SELECTED BY
- 41 THE SRW COMMITTEE CHAIR, AND
- 42 4. THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF PARKING, TRAFFIC,
- 43 AND TRANSPORTATION OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE (EX-
- 44 OFFICIO), AND
- 45 5. THREE (3) STUDENT MEMBERS OF THE GREEK
- 46 COMMUNITY TO BE APPOINTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF
- 47 GREEK AFFAIRS, AND
- 48 6. FOUR (4) STUDENT MEMBERS OF THE OUTLYING AREAS
- 49 SERVED BY THE CURRENT BUS SYSTEM TO BE APPOINTED
- 50 BY THE PRESIDENT, AND CONFIRMED BY A TWO-THIRDS
- 51 VOTE OF THE SENATE, AND
- 52 7. THE PRESIDENT OF STUDENT GOVERNMENT AND OR HIS
- 53 OR HER DESIGNEE, AND
- 54

55 **PARAGRAPH 7:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT QUOROM SHALL CONSIST
56 OF AT LEAST SEVEN (7) MEMBERS, AND

58 **PARAGRAPH 8:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE PURPOSE OF THIS
59 TASK FORCE SHALL BE TO STUDY AND IMPLEMENT AN EFFICIENT
60 BUS ROUTING SYSTEM AND TO WORK TO CREATE A SYSTEM
61 HOLDING DRIVERS MORE ACCOUNTABLE FOR THEIR BREAK TIMES
62 AND ACTIONS TO HELP THE BUS SYTEM RUN MORE EFFICIENTLY
63 AND SMOOTHLY, AND

65 **PARAGRAPH 9:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS TASK FORCE SHALL
66 REMAIN IN EXISTENCE FROM THE DATE OF ENACTMENT UNTIL
67 THE END OF THE FALL SEMESTER OF 2007, AFTER WHICH TIME
68 SAID TASK FORCE SHALL BE DISSOLVED, AND

70 **PARAGRAPH 10:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT SINCE EXISTENCE OF THIS
71 TASK FORCE EXTENDS BEYOND THE REMAINING TERM OF
72 CERTAIN STUDENT GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS, INCLUDING THE
73 STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT AND HIS ADMINISTRATION, THE
74 SPEAKER OF THE SENATE, AND OTHER SENATORS, ANY TASK
75 FORCE MEMBER PROVIDED FOR HEREIN SHALL BE ALLOWED AND
76 ENCOURAGED TO RETAIN MEMBERSHIP ON THE TASK FORCE
77 ONCE HIS OR HER SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED OR ELECTED, WHO
78 SHALL ALSO ASSUME MEMBERSHIP ON THE TASK FORCE, AND

79
80 **PARAGRAPH 11:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE PROVISIONS HEREIN
81 SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE
82 LSU A & M STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE
83 PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR
84 IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY
85 THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
