7 **A RESOLUTION**

9 **TO URGE AND REQUEST THE CHANCELLOR TO APPOINT TWO ADDITIONAL STUDENTS**
10 **TO THE COMMITTEE ON STUDENT CONDUCT; TO CHOOSE FROM A MORE DIVERSE**
11 **GROUP OF STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES; TO HOLD AT LEAST TWO PUBLIC FORUMS PER**
12 **YEAR.**

14 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE VIII OF THE
15 CONSTITUTION OF LOUISIANA, REVISED STATUTES 17:33.51, THE
16 CHANCELLOR OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY, SEAN O'KEEFE,
17 IS AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF LOUISIANA
18 STATE UNIVERSITY "...TO ADOPT, AMEND, OR REPEAL RULES AND
19 REGULATIONS FOR THE GOVERNMENT AND DISCIPLINE OF
20 STUDENTS," AND

22 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, 2.0. STATEMENT OF POLICY OF THE CODE OF
23 STUDENT CONDUCT MANDATES THAT "THE PROPER USE OF THE
24 UNIVERSITY'S DISCIPLINARY POWER IS TO PROTECT THE
25 ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT OF THE CAMPUS AND THE HEALTH AND
26 SAFETY OF ALL MEMBERS OF THE UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY,"
27 AND

29 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE STATEMENT OF POLICY ALSO STATES, "TO
30 ACCOMPLISH THESE OBJECTIVES, THE UNIVERSITY MUST
31 ESTABLISH AND ENFORCE STANDARDS OF CONDUCT FOR ITS
32 STUDENTS. THE UNIVERSITY HAS THE LEGAL RIGHT TO
33 ESTABLISH STANDARDS FOR ACADEMIC AND PERSONAL CONDUCT,
34 FOR MEMBERSHIP AND CONTINUED MEMBERSHIP IN THE
35 UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY, TO DENY MEMBERSHIP TO THOSE
36 APPLICANTS WHO DO NOT MEET THESE STANDARDS, AND TO
37 IMPOSE DISCIPLINARY SANCTIONS ON STUDENTS WHO ARE FOUND
38 IN VIOLATION OF THESE STANDARDS," AND

40 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE STUDENTS ARE NOT ADEQUATELY REPRESENTED
41 UNDER 4.1. MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMITTEE ON STUDENT
42 CONDUCT OF THE CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT, THAT STATES
43 THAT "THE COMMITTEE ON STUDENT CONDUCT SHALL BE
44 COMPRISED OF SEVEN DEANS...FOR THREE-YEAR TERMS; FOUR
45 STUDENTS, APPOINTED ANNUALLY BY THE CHANCELLOR UPON
46 THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE STUDENT
47 GOVERNMENT; SIX FACULTY MEMBERS, APPOINTED BY THE
48 CHANCELLOR FOR THREE-YEAR TERMS TO SERVE AS
49 CHAIRPERSONS OF THE HEARING PANELS; ONE FACULTY MEMBER
50 APPOINTED ANNUALLY BY THE CHANCELLOR UPON THE
51 RECOMMENDATION OF THE FACULTY SENATE EXECUTIVE
52 COMMITTEE; THE DEAN OF STUDENTS; AND THE VICE
53 CHANCELLOR FOR STUDENT LIFE & ACADEMIC SERVICES, WHO
54 SHALL CHAIR THE COMMITTEE," AND

56 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES FROM ALL ASPECTS OF
57 CAMPUS LIFE SHOULD BE CONSIDERED FOR MEMBERSHIP ON THIS
58 COMMITTEE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO,
59 REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE STUDENT EQUALITY COMMISSION,
60 RESIDENTIAL HALLS ASSOCIATION, INTERFRATERNITY COUNCIL,
61 NATIONAL PAN-HELLENIC COUNCIL, PANHELLENIC COUNCIL,
62 INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ASSOCIATION, AGRICULTURAL
63 STUDENTS ASSOCIATION, STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION,
64 AMBASSADORS, TIGERS FOR ISRAEL, UNION PROGRAMMING
65 COUNCIL, AND/OR BLACK STUDENT UNION, AND

67 **PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, 4.2. OF THE CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT OUTLINES
68 THE DUTIES OF THE COMMITTEE ON STUDENT CONDUCT,
69 MANDATING THAT THEY, “REVIEW PERIODICALLY THE
70 PROVISIONS OF THE CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT AND...
71 RECOMMEND CHANGES TO THE OFFICE OF THE CHANCELLOR...
72 [AND THAT THEY] MAY SERVE ON HEARING PANELS THAT
73 CONSIDER FORMAL CHARGES OF MISCONDUCT BY STUDENTS,”
74 AND

76 **PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, THERE HAVE BEEN MANY QUESTIONS AND
77 COMPLAINTS RAISED BY MEMBERS OF THE STUDENT BODY IN
78 REGARDS TO THE FAIRNESS AND LEGITIMACY OF THE CODE OF
79 STUDENT CONDUCT, AND

81 **PARAGRAPH 8:** WHEREAS, THE CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT HAS NOT BEEN
82 REVISED SINCE AUGUST 2002, AND
83

84 **PARAGRAPH 9:** WHEREAS, THE STUDENTS OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY
85 DESERVE TO BE REPRESENTED BY MORE THAN FOUR STUDENTS IN
86 A PANEL OF TWENTY, AND
87

88 **PARAGRAPH 10:** WHEREAS, THE STUDENTS WOULD BENEFIT GREATLY FROM
89 HAVING MORE STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES ON THIS COMMITTEE,
90 SINCE THE CONTENT OF THE CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT
91 DIRECTLY AFFECTS THEM, AND
92

93 **PARAGRAPH 11:** WHEREAS, THE COMMITTEE ON STUDENT CONDUCT SHOULD
94 HOST A MINIMUM OF TWO PUBLIC FORUMS PER YEAR SO THAT
95 THE COMMITTEE CAN BE HELD MORE ACCOUNTABLE AND SO THAT
96 ITS MEMBERS CAN GAIN GREATER STUDENT INPUT,

98 **PARAGRAPH 12:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT
99 GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY
100 AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE
101 THAT CHANCELLOR SEAN O’KEEFE BE URGED TO
102 OPEN THE COMMITTEE ON STUDENT CONDUCT TO A
103 MORE DIVERSE GROUP OF STUDENT
104 REPRESENTATIVES, TO PLACE TWO ADDITIONAL
105 STUDENTS ON THE COMMITTEE, AND TO HOLD AT
106 LEAST TWO PUBLIC FORUMS ON THE REVISIONS
107 BEING MADE TO THE CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT,
108 AND

110 **PARAGRAPH 13:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A SUITABLE COPY OF THIS
111 RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO CHANCELLOR SEAN O'KEEFE,
112 VICE CHANCELLOR FOR STUDENT LIFE & ACADEMIC SERVICES
113 NEIL MATHEWS, DEAN OF STUDENTS K.C. WHITE, AND
114 STUDENT GOVERNMENT PRESIDENT CHRIS ODINET IN A TIMELY
115 AND APPROPRIATE MANNER.
