## A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHT DOLLARS AND TWENTY-SIX CENTS (\$808.26) TO SIGMA ALPHA SORORITY TO DEFRAY FROM THE COST OF SENDING THREE (3) STUDENTS TO THE SIGMA ALPHA AND ALPHA GAMMA RHO LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE IN PHILADELPHIA, PA FROM FEBRUARY 10-12, 2006.

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, SIGMA ALPHA SORORITY IS AN OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION IN GOOD STANDING AT LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY, AND
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, SIGMA ALPHA SORORITY IS THE ONLY PROFESSIONAL AND SOCIAL AGRICULTURAL SORORITY ON THE LSU CAMPUS, AND CONTINUES TO EDUCATE ITS MEMBERS ON AGRICULTURE, LEADERSHIP AND SERVICE, AND
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE TOTAL COST OF TRANSPORATION AND ACCOMIDATIONS FOR THREE (3) STUDENT TO ATTEND THE CONFERENCE IS EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHT DOLLARS AND TWENTY-SIX CENTS (\$808.26), AND
- PARAGRAPH 4:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE HEREBY APPROPRIATE EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHT DOLLARS AND TWENTY-SIX CENTS (\$808.26) TO THE SIGMA ALPHA SORORITY TO HELP DEFRAY FROM THE COST OF TRANSPORTION AND ACCOMIDATIONS FOR THREE (3) STUDENTS TO ATTEND THE SIGMA ALPHA AND ALPHA GAMMA RHO LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE IN PHILADELPHIA, PA FROM FEBRUARY 10-12, 2006.
- PARAGRAPH 5:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
- PARAGRAPH 6:** ALL MONIES NOT EXPENDED BY THE END OF THE 2006 SPRING ACADEMIC SEMESTER WILL REVERT TO THE SENATE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. SHOULD ANY PROVISION OF ARTICLE VI SECTIONS 14 THROUGH 17 OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT BYLAWS BE VIOLATED, RIGHTS TO GRANTED FUNDING WILL BE FORFEITED AND THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID, UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THE RULES.
