## A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE THREE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED EIGHTEEN DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS (\$3218.40) TO THE LSU STUDENT FINANCE ASSOCIATION (SFA) TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF SENDING 8 STUDENTS/DELEGATES TO THE SIXTH ANNUAL GLOBAL STUDENT INVESTMENT FORUM AT THE UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON IN DAYTON, OHIO.

**PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, SFA IS AN OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION AT LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY, AND

**PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, SFA HAS NEVER ATTENDED THE GLOBAL STUDENT INVESTMENT FORUM, AND

**PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, MANY OTHER COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES WILL BE IN ATTENDANCE AT THIS FORUM, AND

**PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE STUDENTS ATTENDING CONFERENCE WILL BE REPRESENTING L.S.U. THROUGHOUT THE WEEKEND ATTENDING SEMINARS, PARTICIPATING IN DISCUSSION FORUMS, NETWORKING WITH PROFESSIONALS AND STUDENTS FROM OTHER UNIVERSITIES. THE STUDENTS ATTENDING WILL ALSO GAIN VALUABLE KNOWLEDGE THROUGHOUT THESE SEMINARS, DISCUSSIONS, AND COMPETITIONS, AND

**PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, SFA WILL NEED APPROXIMATELY \$6,360 TOTAL AND USE THE REVENUE IT HAS GENERATED THUS TO COVER OTHER EXPENSES.

**PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, SFA WILL BE USING ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS TO PAY FOR ACCOMODATIONS.

**PARAGRAPH 7:** THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE DOES HEREBY APPROPRIATE THREE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED EIGHTEEN DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS (\$3218.40) TO THE STUDENT FINANCE ASSOCIATION (SFA) TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF SENDING STUDENTS/DELEGATES TO THE SIXTH ANNUAL GLOBAL STUDENT INVESTMENT FORUM AT THE UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON IN DAYTON, OHIO.

**PARAGRAPH 8:** ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF MAY 1, 2006.

**PARAGRAPH 9:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
