**A BILL**

**TO APPROPRIATE TWO-THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE DOLLARS AND TEN CENTS (\$2261.10) TO THE LSU CHAPTER OF THE NAACP FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE COST OF AIRFARE, LODGING, AND REGISTRATION FOR THREE STUDENTS TO ATTEND THE 2006 REGIONAL NAACP CONVENTION IN MIDWEST CITY, OK MARCH 23-25 2006**

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE LSU CHAPTER OF THE NAACP IS A REGISTERED STUDENT ORGANIZATION WITH THE CENTER FOR STUDENT LEADERSHIP AND INVOLVEMENT, AND
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, MEMBERSHIP IN THE LSU CHAPTER OF THE NAACP IS OPEN TO ALL LSU STUDENTS, AND
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE LSU CHAPTER OF THE NAACP HAS BEEN VERY ACTIVE IN THE PROMOTION OF ITS MISSION AND FOCUS ON CAMPUS AND ELSEWHERE, AND
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, ATTENDANCE AT THIS CONFERENCE WOULD BE BENEFICIAL TO NOT ONLY THE ORGANIZATION ITSELF, BUT ALSO TO LSU AS A WHOLE, AND
- PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THIS CONFERENCE WILL BE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE LSU CHAPTER OF THE NAACP TO INTERACT AND NETWORK WITH OTHER MEMBERS ACROSS THE REGION,
- PARAGRAPH 6:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE TO APPROPRIATE TWO-THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE DOLLARS AND TEN CENTS (\$2261.10) TO THE LSU CHAPTER OF THE NAACP FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE COST OF AIRFARE, LODGING, AND REGISTRATION FOR THREE STUDENTS TO ATTEND THE 2006 REGIONAL NAACP CONVENTION IN MIDWEST CITY, OK MARCH 23-25 2006, AND
- PARAGRAPH 7:** BE IT FURTHER ENACTED THAT THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A THREE-FOURTHS ( $3/4$ ) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL, AND
- PARAGRAPH 8:** BE IT FURTHER ENACTED THAT ALL MONIES NOT EXPENDED BY THE END OF THE 2005-2006 FISCAL YEAR WILL REVERT TO THE SENATE GENERAL CONTINGENCY, AND SHOULD ANY PROVISION OF ARTICLE VI SECTIONS 14 THROUGH 17 OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT BYLAWS BE VIOLATED, RIGHTS TO GRANTED FUNDING WILL BE FORFEITED AND THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID, UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THE RULES.
