A RESOLUTION

TO URGE AND REQUEST THE HONORABLE GOVERNOR KATHLEEN BLANCO TO CONSIDER THE APPOINTMENT OF AN LSU SYSTEM STUDENT OR RECENT GRADUATE AS THE MEMBER AT LARGE TO THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, ONLY ONE STUDENT, WHOM SERVES A TERM OF ONE YEAR, REPRESENTS THE LARGE NUMBER OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM INSTITUTIONS AND,
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE STATE OF LOUISIANA AND THE LSU SYSTEM ARE AT PIVOTAL POINTS IN HISTORY, AND
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, CURRENT STUDENTS AND RECENT GRADUATES HAVE BEEN CITED BY GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS TO BE THE FUTURE OF THE STATE AND,
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, GIVING A STUDENT OR RECENT GRADUATE THE OPPORTUNITY TO SERVE THE LSU SYSTEM AS THE MEMBER-AT-LARGE WOULD SUPPORT AND ENHANCE THIS STATEMENT, AND
- PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, A STUDENT OR RECENT GRADUATE COULD BRING A FRESH PERSPECTIVE TO THE LSU BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, AND
- PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, THIS INDIVIDUAL WOULD BE FIRMLY GROUNDED IN CURRENT ISSUES, INITIATIVES AND CONCERNS OF STUDENTS ON EVERY LSU SYSTEM CAMPUS, AND
- PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, APPOINTING A STUDENT OR RECENT GRADUATE WOULD FURTHER DEVELOP THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE LSU BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND THE STUDENTS IT REPRESENTS, AND
- PARAGRAPH 8:** WHEREAS, THIS INDIVIDUAL WOULD BECOME A LIFELONG ADVOCATE OF THE LSU SYSTEM AND PROMOTE THE INTERESTS OF THE LSU SYSTEM THROUGHOUT THEIR CAREER, AND
- PARAGRAPH 9:** WHEREAS, THIS APPOINTMENT WOULD BE A UNIQUE INVESTMENT IN THE FUTURE LEADERSHIP OF THE STATE OF LOUISIANA, AND
- PARAGRAPH 10:** WHEREAS, THIS APPOINTMENT WOULD REFLECT THE GOVERNOR'S COMMITMENT TO ENHANCE THE FUTURE OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE OF LOUISIANA, AND
- PARAGRAPH 11:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE URGE AND REQUEST THE HONORABLE GOVERNOR KATHLEEN BLANCO TO CONSIDER THE APPOINTMENT OF AN LSU SYSTEM STUDENT AS THE MEMBER-AT-LARGE TO THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND REQUEST THE STATE SENATE CONFIRM THE STUDENT NOMINEE; AND
- PARAGRAPH 12:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A SUITABLE COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO THE HONORABLE GOVERNOR KATHLEEN BLANCO, MEMBERS OF THE LOUISIANA SENATE, THE LSU BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, AND THE CHRONICLE OF HIGHER EDUCATION
