8 **TO APPROPRIATE SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$774) TO THE BETA XI**  
9 **CHAPTER OF PI SIGMA EPSILON: THE ONLY NATIONAL PROFESSIONAL FRATERNITY IN**  
10 **MARKETING, SALES MANAGEMENT, AND SELLING TO DEFRAY THE COST OF SENDING 7**  
11 **STUDENTS TO THE 2005 PI SIGMA EPSILON REGIONAL CONFERENCE OCTOBER 28,**  
12 **2005- OCTOBER 30, 2005 IN NASHVILLE TENNESSEE.**

15 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE BETA XI CHAPTER OF PI SIGMA EPSILON IS AN  
16 OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION IN GOOD STANDING  
17 AT LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY, AND

19 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE BETA XI CHAPTER OF PI SIGMA EPSILON  
20 CONTINUALLY REPRESENTS LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AND  
21 THE E. OURSO COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION TO THE  
22 BEST OF ITS ABILITY HAVING BROUGHT HOME NO LESS THAN A  
23 THIRD PLACE NATIONAL TITLE FOR OVER A DECADE, AND

25 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE TOTAL COST OF ACCOMMODATIONS FOR 7  
26 MEMBERS TO ATTEND THE CONVENTION IS \$1,567, AND  
27

28 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE BETA XI CHAPTER OF PI SIGMA EPSILON WILL  
29 PAY \$113.29 PER PERSON TO EQUAL \$ 793.00 OUT-OF-POCKET.

31 **PARAGRAPH 5:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT  
32 GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY  
33 AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE  
34 HEREBY APPROPRIATES SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR  
35 DOLLARS (\$774.00) TO THE BETA XI CHAPTER OF PI SIGMA  
36 EPSILON TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF REGISTRATION AND  
37 HOTEL ROOMS TO SEND 7 STUDENTS TO THE 2005 PI SIGMA  
38 EPSILON REGIONAL CONFERENCE OCTOBER 28, 2005- OCTOBER  
39 30, 2005 IN NASHVILLE TENNESSEE;

41 **PARAGRAPH 6:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY  
42 VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE  
43 PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR  
44 IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY  
45 THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.

47 **PARAGRAPH 7:** ALL MONIES NOT EXPENDED BY THE END OF THE 2005-2006  
48 FISCAL YEAR WILL REVERT TO THE SENATE GENERAL  
49 CONTINGENCY. SHOULD ANY PROVISION OF ARTICLE VI  
50 SECTIONS 14 THROUGH 17 OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT  
51 BYLAWS BE VIOLATED, RIGHTS TO GRANTED FUNDING WILL BE  
52 FORFEITED AND THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID,  
53 UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THE RULES.
