A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FOURTEEN DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-SIX CENTS (\$2114.86) TO SPECTRUM ALLIANCE TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF ATTENDING THE NATIONAL GAY AND LESBIAN TASK FORCE (NGLTF) CREATING CHANGE CONFERENCE IN MILWAUKEE, WISCONSIN ON NOVEMBER 7-11, 2001

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, SPECTRUM ALLIANCE IS A RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION IN GOOD STANDING, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, ATTENDANCE AT THE NATIONAL GAY AND LESBIAN TASK FORCE CREATING CHANGE CONFERENCE PROVIDES LEADERSHIP SKILLS, NETWORKING ON A NATIONAL LEVEL, AND WORKSHOPS ON LGBT ISSUES AS WELL AS ISSUES OF RACE, CLASS, ABILITY, ETC., AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, SPECTRUM ALLIANCE HAS AN ONGOING COMMITMENT TO THE UNIVERSITY COMMUNITY DEMONSTRATED BY THE SAFE SPACE CAMPAIGN, AND WILL USE THIS CONFERENCE TO ENHANCE THAT PROGRAM ON CAMPUS, IN ADDITION TO ENRICHING THE OFFICE OF MULTICULTURAL AFFAIRS, AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, SPECTRUM ALLIANCE HAS EXPLORED OTHER SOURCES OF FUNDING, AND CONTINUES TO DO SO.

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE DOES HEREBY APPROPRIATE TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FOURTEEN DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-SIX CENTS (\$2114.86) TO SPECTRUM ALLIANCE TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF ATTENDING THE NATIONAL GAY AND LESBIAN TASK FORCE CREATING CHANGE CONFERENCE.

PARAGRAPH 7: ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30TH, 2002.
