A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500) TO THE INSTITUTE OF INDUSTRIAL ENGINEERING (IIE) TO HELP DEFRAY THE LODGING COSTS INCURRED WHILE ATTENDING THE 2002 REGION VII IIE STUDENT CONFERENCE AT THE TENNESSEE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY IN COOKEVILLE, TN ON FEBRUARY 28-MARCH 2, 2002.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE INSTITUTE OF INDUSTRIAL ENGINEERING (IIE) IS A RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION IN GOOD STANDING, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, MEMBERSHIP IN IIE GIVES INDUSTRIAL ENGINEERING STUDENTS EXPOSURE TO INDUSTRY PROFESSIONALS AND IT ALLOWS IE STUDENTS TO COME INTO CONTACT WITH POTENTIAL EMPLOYERS, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, ATTENDEES AT THE IIE CONFERENCE WILL HAVE ACCESS TO POTENTIAL EMPLOYERS THROUGH PLANT TOURS AND A JOB FAIR, AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, ATTENDANCE AT THE CONFERENCE WILL ENCOURAGE MORE EMPLOYERS TO COME TO LSU TO RECRUIT ENGINEERING AND BUSINESS MAJORS.

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE DOES HEREBY APPROPRIATE FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500) TO THE INSTITUTE OF INDUSTRIAL ENGINEERING TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF LODGING FOR THE 2002 REGION VII IIE STUDENT CONFERENCE.

PARAGRAPH 6: ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 2002.
