**A BILL**

TO APPROPRIATE SIX HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$687.00) TO THE SPECTRUM ALLIANCE TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF PRINTING THE OFFICIAL LOUISIANA LGBT CONFERENCE 2001 PROGRAM BOOKLET.

**PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE SPECTRUM ALLIANCE IS A RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION AND IS IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE UNIVERSITY, AND

**PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE SPECTRUM ALLIANCE PROVIDES EDUCATION AND SUPPORT TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE LSU COMMUNITY REGARDLESS OF SEXUAL ORIENTATION OR GENDER IDENTITY, AND

**PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE SPECTRUM ALLIANCE WILL SPONSOR A STATEWIDE LOUISIANA LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL, TRANSGENDER (LGBT) CONFERENCE ON MARCH 30, 31 AND APRIL 1 THAT WILL SERVE TO FOSTER AND EDUCATE ON ISSUES OF DIVERSITY; NOT ONLY THOSE ISSUES THAT AFFECT THE LGBT STUDENTS ON CAMPUS, BUT THOSE THAT AFFECT ALL OTHER MINORITIES AS WELL. THE CONFERENCE WILL ALSO ATTRACT NATIONAL RECOGNITION TO LSU FOR THEIR SUPPORT OF MULTI-CULTURALISM AND DIVERSITY, WHICH NOT ONLY BENEFITS THE UNIVERSITY'S NATIONAL STANDING, BUT THE STUDENT BODY AT LARGE, AND

**PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, A BUDGET SHORTFALL OF SIX HUNDRED AND EIGHTY SEVEN DOLLARS (\$687.00) EXISTS DESPITE THE SPECTRUM ALLIANCE'S SUCCESSFUL SOLICITATION OF \$850.00 AND FACILITIES FOR THE CONFERENCE.

**PARAGRAPH 5:** THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE APPROPRIATES SIX HUNDRED AND EIGHTY SEVEN DOLLARS (\$687.00) TO THE SPECTRUM ALLIANCE TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF SPONSORING THE LOUISIANA LGBT CONFERENCE ON MARCH 30, 31 AND APRIL 1.

**PARAGRAPH 6:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE.

**PARAGRAPH 7:** ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 2001.
