A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$464.00) TO THE LSU BLOCK AND BRIDLE CLUB TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF THE ANNUAL LITTLE INTERNATIONAL LIVESTOCK SHOW ON APRIL 29, 2001.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE LSU BLOCK AND BRIDLE CLUB IS AN OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION AT LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE LSU BLOCK AND BRIDLE CLUB HAS A HISTORY OF SERVICE TO THE COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND THE LSU COMMUNITY AS A WHOLE, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE LSU BLOCK AND BRIDLE CLUB WILL SPONSOR THE LITTLE INTERNATIONAL LIVESTOCK SHOW ON APRIL 29, 2001 THAT WILL SERVE TO ALLOW STUDENTS, FACULTY AND PARENTS THE OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN LIVESTOCK SHOWING; FORMER PARTICIPANTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THESE ACTIVITIES THROUGH ORGANIZATIONS SUCH AS 4-H AND FFA AFTER HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION; THIS EVENT WOULD ALLOW THESE FORMER AND NEW PARTICIPANTS TO FURTHER THEIR PARTICIPATION IN LIVESTOCK SHOWING, AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THERE IS A BUDGET SHORTFALL FOR THE LITTLE INTERNATIONAL LIVESTOCK SHOW DESPITE THE SUCCESSFUL SOLICITATION OF AREA BUSINESSES AND PRIVATE SPONSORS.

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE DOES HEREBY APPROPRIATE FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$464.00) TO THE LSU BLOCK AND BRIDLE CLUB TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF SPONSORING THE LITTLE INTERNATIONAL LIVESTOCK SHOW.

PARAGRAPH 6: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE LSU A&M SENATE.

PARAGRAPH 7: ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 2001.
