A RESOLUTION

TO SHOW STUDENT SUPPORT FOR THE UNIVERSITY ADMINISTRATION TO FIND A PERMANENT SPACE FOR THE LSU A&M WOMEN'S CENTER, WITH THE SUGGESTION OF USING THE HELEN M.CARTER HOUSE AS A POSSIBLE LOCATION.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, WOMEN CONSTITUTE A MAJORITY OF STUDENTS ON THE LSU A&M CAMPUS, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE LSU A&M WOMEN'S CENTER PROVIDES SUPPORT, REFERRAL, AND INFORMATION TO THE ENTIRE CAMPUS COMMUNITY ON ISSUES AND CONCERNS RELATING TO WOMEN, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, CURRENTLY THE LSU A&M WOMEN'S CENTER IS LOCATED ON THE THIRD FLOOR OF HATCHER HALL (A CONDEMNED BUILDING), AND SHALL HAVE TO RELOCATE IN THE NEAR FUTURE TO MAKE WAY FOR RENOVATIONS SO THAT THEIR CURRENT LOCATION CAN HOUSE THE DEPARTMENT OF THEATER IN THE FUTURE, AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, A NEED FOR SPACE EXISTS CONCERNING THE FUTURE LOCATION OF THE LSU A&M WOMEN'S CENTER, AND

PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, THE HELEN M.CARTER HOUSE IS NOT CONDEMNED, AND HAS RECENTLY BEEN VACATED, AND IS CENTRALLY LOCATED NEXT TO RESIDENCE HALLS AND THE AFRICAN-AMERICAN CULTURAL CENTER, AND

PARAGRAPH 6: WHEREAS, THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT REPRESENTS THE VOICES AND CONCERNS OF ALL STUDENTS.

PARAGRAPH 7: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE ENCOURAGES THE UNIVERSITY ADMINISTRATION TO PROVIDE A PERMANENT SPACE FOR THE WOMEN'S CENTER, WITH A STRONG SUGGESTION OF, BUT NOT LIMITING THE SEARCH TO THE HELEN M. CARTER HOUSE.
