**A BILL**

TO APPROPRIATE FIVE HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$539.80) TO THE LSU CREATIVE WRITING PROGRAM TO HELP DEFRAY PRODUCTION AND PROMOTIONAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE STAGING OF *ALIEN BUNDLES* AND *BUT FOR THE GRACE OF GOD, THERE GO I!*

**PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE CREATIVE WRITING PROGRAM IS A RECOGNIZED AND PRESTIGIOUS COMPONENT OF THE LSU DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH, AND

**PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, PAST READINGS AND PRODUCTIONS PRESENTED BY THE CREATIVE WRITING PROGRAM HAVE BENEFITTED LSU STUDENTS BY OFFERING STAGE EXPERIENCE TO THE CASTS AND JOY TO AUDIENCES, AND

**PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE CREATIVE WRITING PROGRAM HAS ANNOUNCED PLANS FOR TWO NEW WORKS—*ALIEN BUNDLES* AND *BUT FOR THE GRACE OF GOD, THERE GO I!*—TO BE PRODUCED DURING THE 1999-2000 SCHOOL YEAR.

**PARAGRAPH 4:** THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE HEREBY APPROPRIATES FIVE HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$539.80) TO THE LSU DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH CREATIVE WRITING PROGRAM TO DEFRAY PRODUCTION AND PROMOTIONAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE STAGING OF *ALIEN BUNDLES* AND *BUT FOR THE GRACE OF GOD, THERE GO I!*

**PARAGRAPH 5:** ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT BACK TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 2000.
