A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE DOLLARS AND FORTY-TWO CENTS (\$721.42) TO THE LSU BLACK STUDENT UNION (BSU) TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF THE FIRST ANNUAL BLACK STUDENT UNION SCHOLARSHIP BALL TO BE HELD AT THE LOD COOK ALUMNI CENTER ON APRIL 14, 2000.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE BSU WILL BE HOSTING A FORMAL BALL OPEN TO ALL LSU STUDENTS, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE BSU WILL HONOR AFRICAN-AMERICAN FACULTY, STAFF, AND GRADUATING SENIORS AT THIS AFFAIR, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, SOME FUNDING HAS ALREADY BEEN SECURED AND ADDITIONAL MONIES WILL BE RAISED THROUGH TICKET SALES.

PARAGRAPH 4: THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE HEREBY APPROPRIATES SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE DOLLARS AND FORTY-TWO CENTS (\$721.42) TO THE LSU BLACK STUDENT UNION (BSU) TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF THE FIRST ANNUAL BLACK STUDENT UNION SCHOLARSHIP BALL TO BE HELD AT THE LOD COOK ALUMNI CENTER ON APRIL 14, 2000.

PARAGRAPH 5: ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 2000.
