**A RESOLUTION**

**TO STATE THAT THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE SUPPORTS THE ADMINISTRATION'S  
DECISION NOT TO ENDORSE THE DISPLAY OF THE PURPLE AND GOLD CONFEDERATE  
BATTLE FLAG.**

**PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, MANY STUDENTS EXPRESS AN ONGOING CONCERN WITH THE DISPLAY OF THE PURPLE AND GOLD CONFEDERATE BATTLE FLAG, AND

**PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE HAS THE RESPONSIBILITY TO VOICE CONCERNS OF THE STUDENT BODY, AND

**PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, LSU A&M IS EASILY RECOGNIZED BY THE COLORS PURPLE AND GOLD, AND

**PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE CONFEDERATE BATTLE FLAG IN THE COLORS OF PURPLE AND GOLD COLORS HAS NO HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE OR BENEFIT TO THE LSU A&M COMMUNITY, AND

**PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, UPON PASSAGE OF THIS RESOLUTION, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE HOPES TO CREATE A MORE HARMONIOUS ATMOSPHERE ON ITS CAMPUS.

**PARAGRAPH 6:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE SUPPORTS THE ADMINISTRATION'S DECISION NOT TO ENDORSE THE DISPLAY OF THE PURPLE AND GOLD CONFEDERATE BATTLE FLAG.
