**A BILL**

TO APPROPRIATE EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$800) TO THE INDIAN STUDENT ASSOCIATION OF LSU A&M FOR ITS SPRING BANQUET TO BE HELD MARCH 26, 1999.

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE INDIAN STUDENT ASSOCIATION OF LSU IS PLANNING TO HOLD A BANQUET TO PROMOTE KNOWLEDGE OF THE TRADITIONS AND CULTURE OF INDIA AND HER PEOPLE, AND
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, INTERACTION AMONG STUDENTS, ADMINISTRATION, FACULTY, AND STAFF AT THE BANQUET WILL ENHANCE THE EDUCATIONAL AND SOCIAL EXPERIENCE AT LSU A&M, AND
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE INDIAN STUDENT ASSOCIATION OF LSU IS A RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION AND HAS RAISED APPROXIMATELY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000) OF THE PROJECTED SIX THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED DOLLAR (\$6,100) COST OF THE EVENT THROUGH MEMBERSHIP FEES, TICKET SALES, DONATIONS, AND CORPORATE SPONSORSHIP, AND
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE INDIAN STUDENT ASSOCIATION OF LSU WILL EXHAUST THE MONEY IT HAS ALLOCATED FOR ITS 1999 ANNUAL SPRING BANQUET, AND
- PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THE LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT SHALL BE LISTED AS A CO-SPONSOR OF THE EVENT ACCORDING TO ARTICLE VI, SECTION 15, SUBSECTIONS A, B, AND C OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT BYLAWS.
- PARAGRAPH 6:** THEREFORE, EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$800) IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED FROM THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY TO THE INDIAN STUDENT ASSOCIATION OF LSU TO HELP FINANCE ITS ANNUAL CULTURAL BANQUET.
- PARAGRAPH 7:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE.
- PARAGRAPH 8:** ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY.
- PARAGRAPH 9:** THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 1999.
