A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE FIVE HUNDRED NINETY-THREE DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-FOUR CENTS (\$593.84) FOR THE PURCHASE OF TEN (10) OFFICE TABLES AND TWENTY (20) FOLDING CHAIRS TO BE PLACED IN THE LOBBY OF CHOPPIN HALL.

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE LOBBY OF CHOPPIN HALL SERVES AS A STUDY AREA, LOUNGE, AND MEETING SITE FOR STUDENTS OF ALL COLLEGES, AND
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE LOBBY IS USED BY AN EXTREMELY HIGH VOLUME OF STUDENTS DAILY, AND
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE TABLES AND CHAIRS CURRENTLY IN PLACE ARE INADEQUATE AND IN EXTREMELY POOR CONDITION, AND
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, IMPROVING THE LOBBY AREA WOULD AFFORD STUDENTS A MORE ATTRACTIVE AND SUITABLE INDOOR ENVIRONMENT IN WHICH TO RELAX, EAT, AND STUDY.
- PARAGRAPH 5:** THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE APPROPRIATES FIVE HUNDRED NINETY-THREE DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-FOUR CENTS (\$593.84) FOR THE PURCHASE OF TEN (10) OFFICE TABLES AND TWENTY (20) FOLDING CHAIRS FOR THE LOBBY OF CHOPPIN HALL.
- PARAGRAPH 6:** ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 1999.
